Thank you for your request received by North of England Commissioning Support (NECS) on 18th August for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

For information Clinical Commissioning Groups ceased to exist on 30 June 2022. Services that were previously delivered by the CCG are now being delivered by the successor organisation NHS North East and North Cumbria (ICB). This covers the areas of County Durham, Newcastle Gateshead, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland and Tees Valley.

The names of staff members within the safeguarding team are exempt from disclosure under Section 38 Health and Safety of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, specifically s. 38 (b) where information is exempt if disclosure would or would be likely to endanger the safety of any individual.

As section 38 is a 'qualified exemption', it requires NHS North East and North Cumbria ICB to demonstrate the prejudice which would occur if the information were to be released, and to consider whether the public interest is in favour of releasing the information regardless. The outcome of the public interest test has been shared below:

Public Interest Test:

Considerations in favour of disclosure:

- Transparency of functions; procurement and services to NHS
- Encourage and instil trust and confidence
- promoting accountability and transparency by public authorities for decisions taken by them

Considerations against disclosure:

- ICB Tees Valley and Primary Care are currently operating under contingency measures which preclude the sharing of staff personal details. These measures have been informed by NHS Local Security Management Specialists.
- Any and all safeguarding questions or concerns will reach the appropriate Safeguarding Designated Professionals via the generic email provided.

Having undertaken the balancing exercise, NHS North East and North Cumbria ICB has concluded that the public interest in maintaining the exemption outweighs the public interest in disclosing the requested information.

In line with the Information Commissioner's directive on the disclosure of information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 your request will form part of our disclosure log. Therefore, a version of our response which will protect your anonymity will be posted on the NHS ICB website https://northeastnorthcumbria.nhs.uk/.

If you are unhappy with the service you have received in relation to your request and wish to make a complaint or request a review of our decision, you should write to the Senior Governance Manager using the contact details at the top of this letter quoting the appropriate reference number.

Generally, the Information Commissioner cannot make a decision unless you have exhausted the complaints procedure provided by The North of England Commissioning Support Unit.
