<u>Freedom of Information Act 2000 - Request for Information - NHS North East & North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (ICB)</u>

Thank you for your request received by North of England Commissioning Support (NECS) on 16 August 2022 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

For information Clinical Commissioning Groups ceased to exist on 30 June 2022. Services that were previously delivered by the CCG are now being delivered by the successor organisation NHS North East and North Cumbria (ICB). This covers County Durham, Newcastle Gateshead, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland and Tees Valley.

Details of Request

I have a formulary question that I hope you can help me with:

Due to the newly created 'NHS North East and North Cumbria', are there any plans to consolidate the formularies below, if so what is the timeline and where would the new formulary be published?

Lancashire & South Cumbria Medicines Management Group
Morecambe Bay Joint Medicines Formulary
North of Tyne, Gateshead and North Cumbria APC
Northern England NHS Treatment Advisory Group (NTAG)
South Tyneside and Sunderland Area Prescribing Committee

Response

Discussions are ongoing with stakeholders about whether a single formulary is desirable and achievable. The timelines of this are still to be confirmed, as is the place it would be published if it were achieved.

For note, this will not apply to Lancashire & South Cumbria Medicines Management Group and Morecambe Bay Joint Medicines Formulary which fall outside of the footprint of the ICB.
