Freedom of Information Act 2000 - Request for Information - NHS North East & North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (ICB)

Thank you for your request received by North of England Commissioning Support (NECS) on 23 August 2022 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

For information Clinical Commissioning Groups ceased to exist on 30 June 2022. Services that were previously delivered by the CCG are now being delivered by the successor organisation NHS North East and North Cumbria (ICB). This covers the areas Durham. Newcastle Gateshead. North Cumbria. North Tyneside. County Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland and Tees Valley.

Details of Request

I was wondering if it would be possible to provide me with the updated email addresses for GP practices now that CCG's have migrated to ICB's as I have noticed some that I hold no longer work. I understand that this may take a while and is sensitive information, this is in relation to work I do alongside Durham Constabulary for TEWV in relation to referrals (I am an NHS employee). I have previously gotten the information from the information governance manager(s) at the respective CCG's but do not know if I now need to request this centrally now that they have changed to Integrated Care Boards.
