## <u>Freedom of Information Act 2000 - Request for Information - NHS North East & North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (ICB)</u>

Thank you for your request received by North of England Commissioning Support (NECS) on 29 September 2022 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

For information Clinical Commissioning Groups ceased to exist on 30 June 2022. Services that were previously delivered by the CCG are now being delivered by the successor organisation NHS North East and North Cumbria (ICB). This covers the areas of County Durham, Newcastle Gateshead, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland and Tees Valley.

## **Details of Request**

I'd like to request NHS North East and North Cumbria ICB answers the following questions under the Freedom of Information Act.

As I appreciate the Integrated Care Board (ICB) has only recently been established, for questions where I'm asking for historical data (2015 - present) I'm looking for the data held, if possible, by the previous CCGs which now form your ICB:

NHS North Tyneside CCG

NHS Northumberland CCG

NHS Newcastle Gateshead CCG

NHS North Cumbria CCG

NHS Sunderland CCG

NHS South Tyneside CCG

NHS County Durham CCG

NHS Tees Valley CCG

The questions I would like answered are as follows:

- 1. Could you provide your actual inpatient rates for Transforming Care (learning disabilities & autism) patients for each year since 2015 to present.
- 2. Could you provide your target rate for Transforming Care (learning disabilities & autism) patients for each corresponding year?
- 3. Since 2015, have you required NHS England intervention or oversight at any stage relating to your delivery of Transforming Care services?
- 4. How many of your inpatients since 2015 have been discharged into private hospital or healthcare settings?
- 5. How much have you spent on delivering Transforming Care services each year since 2015?
- 6. If mechanical restraint is used within your organisation, how many recorded instances of its use have there been each year since 2015?
- 7. If mechanical restraint is used within your organisation, what are the methods of mechanical restraint currently used?
- 8. How often are these methods and guidelines reviewed and, if necessary, updated?
