<u>Freedom of Information Act 2000 - Request for Information – NHS North East & North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (ICB)</u>

Thank you for your request received by North of England Commissioning Support (NECS) on 26 July 2022 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

For information Clinical Commissioning Groups ceased to exist on 30 June 2022. Services that were previously delivered by the CCG are now being delivered by the successor organisation NHS North East and North Cumbria (ICB). This covers County Durham, Newcastle Gateshead, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland and Tees Valley.

Details of Request

Please provide a copy of any documents pertaining to any Locally Enhanced Scheme (LES) or similar, specifically with regard to payments to practices within primary care for the administration of Gonadorelins and/or Degarelix (Firmagon).

Response

County Durham

The Local Improvement and Integration Scheme (LIAISE) incentive scheme sets out (section 11 Enhanced Treatments) that practices will prescribe GnRH analogue therapy - prescription and administration of GnRH analogue therapy to ambulant adult patients as directed by a suitably qualified specialist.

GnRH antagonists and degarelix are categorised as 'green plus' on the local formulary which means that it should only be prescribed following specialist initiation or recommendation. Practices do not get additional payment for the administration of this group of drugs.
