Message from Alan Foster



Enhanced Response Area

Last week it was announced that from this Monday the whole of the North East would receive additional government support as an Enhanced Response Area following a steep rise in Covid-19 cases in the area. While we are currently seeing a decline in cases of Covid-19 in the community we can't be complacent particularly as we know many front-line services remain very busy and cases in our hospitals continue to rise – although covid-19 admissions to hospital are

not at the levels they were earlier in the pandemic.

Our best defence against virus remains the vaccine. Across the region we have worked tirelessly to ensure as many people as possible are protected and the vaccine is accessible to all. I know this hard work continues and we are also planning for the Covid-19 booster and flu vaccination programmes.

Together – across all partners – we are sharing important messages with the public and continue to ask for their support - as well as thanking them for all they have done already. Whether that's getting the vaccine, self-isolating and getting a test if they have covid-19 symptoms or remembering to wash their hands, wear a mask and social distancing when visiting any healthcare settings. Chair designate of the ICS

I am delighted to share with you that this week NHS England/Improvement have confirmed that Professor Sir Liam Donaldson will be chair-designate for the Integrated Care Board for the North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care System (ICS).

As you will be aware, Sir Liam is <u>currently chair of the ICS and was appointed in</u> <u>December 2020</u>. He is passionate about working with local authority colleagues to reduce the burden of premature death and preventable disease and the longstanding health inequalities that affect many parts of the region. He also shares the commitment of all staff working in these vital public services to do everything possible to deliver safe high quality care appropriate and accessible to everyone who needs it.

The next stage of the recruitment process will be the appointment of the ICB chief officers designates, with this process expected to conclude in the Autumn.

This week I was also delighted to hear that Amanda Pritchard has been appointed a chief executive of NHS England/Improvement. We look forward to playing our part in working with Amanda and all our partners across the region to ensure the NHS continues to be the best health and care system in the world.
